Waverly's Way Day of Free Tutoring on January 23rd was so successful that some of the 32 JIT (Just In Time) Tutors asked to help students in grades 4-12 again on January 30th. They brought expertise in all major subjects K-12, plus Computer Education, Economics, Mandarin, Pre-Calculus, Psychology and Spanish. Some had experience tutoring students with disabilities, ADHD and Dyslexia, in addition to using techniques to address honors and gifted students.

One high school student in danger of failing Geometry and being retained earned a "B+" after two days with a WW JIT tutor. Parents and students offered superlative comments about the tutoring experiences, and all students who completed specific assignments during the TWO days of free tutoring submitted to their respective teachers "B" and "A" work. Students who received help are from Florida and Georgia. Tutors are from Florida, Georgia, Maryland and New Jersey.
